ADDENDUM TO ANNUAL APPLICATION/RENEWAL

ARTICLE FOUR: MEMBERSHIP

4.1 There shall be a class of voting members and a class of non-voting members of the corporation.

- (a) Voting members. To become a voting member of the corporation, a person must belong to one of the following categories of practitioners:
 - (1) An attorney licensed to practice in the state of Colorado;
 - (2) A psychiatrist or other licensed mental health professional;
 - (3) A mediator who has completed at least 40 hours of mediation training in a divorce or child custody mediation training program;
 - (4) A person who has been deemed qualified for voting membership by vote of the Board of Directors after submission of a request for membership by the person requesting such membership; or
 - (5) All persons who are current members of IDC as of November, 1994.

A person requesting membership to be granted by vote of the Board of Directors in this Paragraph 4.1.(a)(4), may apply to become a voting member by submitting a letter requesting voting membership to the President of the Corporation. The President of the Corporation shall, within 30 days of his/her receipt of such letter of request, submit the same to the Board of Directors for their vote to approve or disapprove such request at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. The request for membership shall be considered granted upon approval by a majority vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors.

(b) Non-Voting Members. Other members of the community may be members of the IDC entitling them to participate in IDC functions, attend educational forums at membership rates, and be on the IDC mailing list, but may not be voting members of the corporation. Such non-voting members may include, but are not limited to, paralegals who are presently working for an attorney involved in the practice of domestic relations law, mediators without professional training or with training not approved by the Board of Directors, law students, mental health students, and mental health practitioners who are not licensed to practice in the state of Colorado. Any person who wishes to apply for non-voting membership must submit a letter requesting membership to the President of the Corporation. The President shall within 30 days of his/her receipt of such letter of request, submit the same to the Board of Directors for their vote to approve or disapprove such request at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. The request for membership shall be considered granted upon approval by a majority vote of a quorum of the Board of Directors.

(c) Attendance at Meetings. Except for conferences or other educational seminars specifically promoted to the public, only persons who meet the criteria established for membership in parts (a) and (b) of this paragraph 4.1 shall be entitled to attend the meetings, conferences, or seminars of the IDC.
